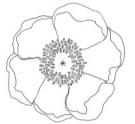

**Rules and Regulations for Pavilion Entries**

Entries can be registered from 9<sup>th</sup> October via mail or email.

All Exhibits must be lodged in person directly to the Holmfield Pavilion through the Simmie St entrance.

Exhibits (Open) will not be accepted until the entry fee has been paid.

**All Work must be the bona fide work of the exhibitor.**

**There is a limit of two exhibits per class for each exhibitor.**

Entry tickets must be firmly attached to all entries before lodging with the stewards.

**All Exhibits must have been completed within the last twelve months.**

**Entry Fees:** Junior Sections: Free entry

**Judging:** Judging will commence at 10AM on Saturday the 10th of November;  
No entry into the pavilion will occur whilst judging is being completed.

Judges will not consider any exhibit that is dirty, worn or spoiled, and entries that do not meet the rules associated with the class or section.

The Chief Steward is responsible for the final decision where judges cannot make a clear determination regarding any exhibit; including moving the exhibit into a class which is more suitable.

The Chief Steward reserves the right to create; where required, a sub-class within a class; for judging purposes. Prize cards will be awarded in this sub-class in addition to the class being judged.

**Collection of Entries:**

All entries can be picked up on Sunday the 11th of November after 3PM, unless prior arrangements have been made with the chief steward.

Entries that are to be picked up not by the exhibitor will need to provide evidence that they have the authority to act on behalf of the exhibitor.

Collection of entries after Sunday can be negotiated with the Chief Steward.

Entries not collected by November the 18<sup>th</sup> will be donated to the Salvation Army Opportunity Shop, or discarded.

**Awards:** First, Second and Third Places will be awarded, except where there are less than 6 entries In any class. Junior classes that exceed 10 entries will have 4th, 5th and 6th prize cards awarded.

**Sponsorship / Prizes:** Where prizes are awarded, these may be collected from the Chief Steward at 3 PM on Sunday the 11<sup>th</sup> of November. Unclaimed cash prizes will be returned to Sponsors, unclaimed prize goods will remain the property of the Echuca-Moama Show Society, and will be utilised in the 2019 Pavilion entries. Prizes not claimed by Sunday the 18<sup>th</sup> of November 2017, will be null and void, and no claim can be made against them.

Champion of Sections will receive a Gold Certificate.

Highly Commended will be awarded a silver certificate at the Judge's discretion.

**All cookery must be presented on a paper/plastic plate or cake board.

Cup-cakes and muffins may be exhibited in patty papers.**
